To: Joyce Weymouth, Resident of the Town of St. Albans, Maine in the County of Somerset.

**GREETINGS:**

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby requested to notify and warn the voters of the Town of St. Albans in said Somerset County, qualified by law to vote in town affairs, to meet at the St. Albans Town Hall, 7 Water Street in said Town on the 21st day of August A.D., 2021 at 9:00 o'clock a.m. in the morning to act on the following articles, to wit:

Art. 1. To elect a Moderator by written ballot to preside at said meeting.

Art. 2. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Municipal Officers to transfer up to eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000) from the Fire Hall Capital Reserve Account and purchase of ten (10) new air packs.

Art. 3. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Board of Selectmen to accept the conveyance of an easement in perpetuity from BCW Corporation, and other property owners in common, on a half-mile section of Pond Road, beginning where the town-owned section of road ends and ending at the south side of the intersection of Cliffside Drive and Pond Road.

Art. 4. To see if the Town will vote to authorize the Municipal Officers to negotiate an agreement with Maine Department of Transportation (MDOT) for the purpose of installing a permanent replacement bridge on Webb Ridge Road.

(MDOT has proposed to share the costs of engineering, and to reimburse the Town of St. Albans for eighty percent (80%) of the project's construction costs. Under their proposal, the town would be responsible for one hundred percent of the initial cost of construction, which would require further approval by the citizens for financing of the project, said costs to be determined upon completion of engineered plans. Under the MDOT proposal the town would assume ownership of the new bridge upon its completion.)


Art. 5. To see if the Town will vote to enact the attached Recreation Ordinance – to authorize the Municipal Officers to create a five-person Recreation Board for the purpose of administering baseball, community events, and sports clinics for the benefit of the citizens and families who reside in of St. Albans and to allow the Town of St Albans to provide insurance for the participants.


**A person who is not a registered voter of St. Albans may not vote at town meeting.**


You are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting in a public and conspicuous place seven (7) days at least before the holding of said meeting.

Hereof fail not and have this warrant with your doings thereon at the time and place mentioned.




